Job 36:22-24 (CEV)

22 God's power is unlimited. He needs no teachers

23 to guide or correct him.

24 Others have praised God for what he has done, so join with them.

Psalm 78:40-42 (NKJV)

40 How often they provoked Him in the wilderness, And grieved Him in the desert!

41 Yes, again and again they tempted God, And limited the Holy One of Israel.

42 They did not remember His power: The day when He redeemed them from the enemy,

We serve a God that is unlimited. He does not have any boundaries, except when we limit Him, because of our unbelief. How does this happen?

Most of us don't realize the power of our WORDS. When we speak about our circumstances, challenges and even our nation, we are actually laying a foundation for our lives and futures. God had amazing plans for the Children of Israel. However, their words held Him back from fulfilling His promises to them.

Learning to properly control our tongues and manage our words will release the supernatural power of God and take the limits off of our lives. With this in mind, let's examine: **The Only Limits Are In Us**

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

What we hear consistently, effects our ability to believe God. That's why it's so important for us to remain in environments where the gospel is taught. If

faith can come by hearing, so can doubt and unbelief. The quality of word we receive determines what we believe.

1. Hearing consistent faith filled words removes our limits.

Proverbs 18:21 (MSG)

21 Words kill, words give life; they're either poison or fruit—you choose.

God is all powerful. However, He's given that power over to us. The ability to limit or remove limits from our lives has been endued to one of our smallest members, our tongues. Life and death are within the scope of the tongue's power.

2. Speaking right or wrong words determines our limits.

Luke 6:45 (NLT)

45 A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart. What you say flows from what is in your heart.

Our hearts are the birthplace of all increase and decrease in our lives. Many people are ignorant of the fact that their words are always producing. Our hearts are the factories that provide material for production. You and I can only go as far as our hearts can take us.

3. Good and evil in our lives is produced by our heart's limits.

Proverbs 11:9 (NLT)

9 With their words, the godless destroy their friends, but knowledge will rescue the righteous.

Everything in this life will come out of a conversation with someone. Moses had a conversation with God and received God's perfect law. Eve had a conversation with a snake and lost the perfect Garden God had prepared. Learning to properly use our words will determine the degree of success we find in our relationships.

4. Our words establish the limits of our relationships.

Romans 10:8 (NKJV)

8 But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach):

The Bible is clear. Faith comes by hearing. And, what we hear determines the treasury of our hearts. When enough faith is built up in our hearts, it will begin to spill out of our mouths and become the material for our conversations. That’s when the limits begin to be taken off our friends and families.

5. Our faith-filled words remove limits from the lives of others.
