

Unlimited Faith

2 Thessalonians 1:3 (NIV)

3 We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

Just like our bodies have an unlimited capacity to grow, our faith does as well. At salvation, we are all given the measure of faith. It's the same way, with our physical muscles. We all have the same amount. However, some have learned the importance of exercising theirs. Even though we have the same amount, those who exercise can do things with what they have, that others aren't able to pull off. There is nothing you and I can't do, if we learn how to properly operate in faith. With this in common, let's examine:

UNLIMITED FAITH.

Hebrews 11:1 (AMP)

11 Now faith is the assurance (title deed, confirmation) of things hoped for (divinely guaranteed), and the evidence of things not seen [the conviction of their reality—faith comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses].

Faith gives us options. Everything you and I are believing God for, is available to us. Faith not only proves that it's out there. It is proof that it already belongs to us. When you own a car, you don't have to see the car, if you have the title. The title is proof that the care belongs to you. **FAITH IS PROOF THAT WHAT YOU'RE BELIEVING FOR IS ALREADY YOURS.**

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Mark 11:23 (NKJV)

23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart,

but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Have you ever tried to communicate with someone who didn't speak the same language as you. You were both frustrated, because of a lack of comprehension. Faith is God's language. Our faith is only limited by our comprehension of God's language. Words of faith must be said. And, they must be heard, by you and your situation. The question is, who are you hearing? **The word of man brings doubt. The word of the enemy brings fear. The word of God brings faith.**

2. Unlimited faith is a _____ that must be spoken.

Mark 4:35-41 (NLT)

35 As evening came, Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's cross to the other side of the lake."

36 So they took Jesus in the boat and started out, leaving the crowds behind (although other boats followed).

37 But soon a fierce storm came up. High waves were breaking into the boat, and it began to fill with water.

38 Jesus was sleeping at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. The disciples woke him up, shouting, "Teacher, don't you care that we're going to drown?"

39 When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Silence! Be still!" Suddenly the wind stopped, and there was a great calm.

40 Then he asked them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

41 The disciples were absolutely terrified. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "Even the wind and waves obey him!"

There will always be an enemy that wars against the life of the believer. The winds and waves were contrary forces coming against the disciples.

They were blessed to have someone onboard who knew the language of the Kingdom. The language of God is always stronger than the language of the enemy. The force of faith behind Jesus words was strong enough to stop the force of the storm. **NO MATTER IF IT'S A STORM, GIANT, SIKNESS, DEBT, LACK, - FAITH IS STRONGER THAN ALL THAT!!!**

3. Unlimited faith is an _____ and irresistible force.

Psalm 119:18 (AMP)

18 Open my eyes [to spiritual truth] so that I may behold Wonderful things from Your law.

Psalm 119:97-100 (AMP)

97 Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day.

98 Your commandments make me wiser than my enemies, For Your words are always with me.

99 I have better understanding and deeper insight than all my teachers [because of Your word], For Your testimonies are my meditation.

100 I understand more than the aged [who have not observed Your precepts], Because I have observed and kept Your precepts.

Prayer and meditation are the keys to revelation of faith principles. The Word of God never changes. However, our understanding of it does. Our circumstances don't change the Word. But, our understanding of the Word can change any circumstance. Listening to multiple scriptures for 10 hours isn't nearly as valuable as meditating on 1 scripture for 10 hours. **You can bite an orange or squeeze an orange. But a bite cannot produce what a squeeze can.**

4. Unlimited faith is realized through prayer for _____ of God's Word.

Matthew 9:27-29 (NLT)

27 After Jesus left the girl's home, two blind men followed along behind him, shouting, "Son of David, have mercy on us!"

28 They went right into the house where he was staying, and Jesus asked them, "Do you believe I can make you see?" "Yes, Lord," they told him, "we do."

29 Then he touched their eyes and said, "Because of your faith, it will happen."

The scripture says, "The people who know their God will be strong and do exploits. We all move from faith to faith, from one level to another level in the operation of faith. It becomes easier to believe God for the big things, when you've already seen Him do the small things. The operation of faith comes with knowing God. **FAITH IS ABOUT KNOWING THAT IF GOD DID IT BEFORE, HE'LL DO IT AGAIN.**
