Psalm 115:14-15 (NKJV)

14 May the Lord give you increase more and more, You and your children.

15 May you be blessed by the Lord, Who made heaven and earth.

Unlimited Increase

We were all created by God to grow and increase. Every living organism has one thing in common. We all have the ability to grow. Anything living, should be growing. If it's not growing, it's either sick or dying.

God wants to bless us with unlimited increase. His desire is not to bless and increase us to a certain point and then stop. His way is systematic, perpetual increase. He says, "I know if I keep blessing him/her My will is going to be accomplished in the Earth. With this in mind, let's examine:

Unlimited Increase

Genesis 1:28 (AMP)

28 And God blessed them [granting them certain authority] and said to them, "Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subjugate it [putting it under your power]; and rule over (dominate) the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth."

Luke 12:32 says, "It pleases God to give us the kingdom. God is excited and overjoyed to bless and blow the minds of His people. Notice that we didn't just say people. We said His people. His people are submitted to His ways and His will. God always gives His people certain (absolute) authority. **The Kingdom always has a certain order.**

1. Unlimited increase is the will of God for _____ people.

2 Kings 4:3-6 (NLT)

3 And Elisha said, “Borrow as many empty jars as you can from your friends and neighbors.

4 Then go into your house with your sons and shut the door behind you. Pour olive oil from your flask into the jars, setting each one aside when it is filled.”

5 So she did as she was told. Her sons kept bringing jars to her, and she filled one after another.

6 Soon every container was full to the brim! “Bring me another jar,” she said to one of her sons. “There aren’t any more!” he told her. And then the olive oil stopped flowing.

Your ability to hold and willingness to stretch will determine how much of God’s supernatural increase you see in operation in your life. Many people don’t receive, because there’s no space left in their bowl. In the scripture, as long as they had pots, the oil continued to flow. **YOU CAN ONLY HOLD WHAT YOU HAVE MADE ROOM FOR.**

2. Unlimited increase is regulated by our _____ to receive.

Job 8:7 (NASB)

7 Though your beginning was insignificant, Yet your end will increase greatly.

Job 8:7 (NLT)

7 And though you started with little, you will end with much.

When the empowerment for unlimited increase hits a man/woman’s life, it really doesn’t matter where they started. They will always end up in abundance. You can exchange a predictable future for a God-given destiny. The Bible says, “Although you started out with nothing, I’m going to give you everything.”– **WE GO FROM FAITH TO FAITH, GLORY TO GLORY, LEVEL TO LEVEL!!**

3. Unlimited increase is the catalyst for consistent _____ changes.

Genesis 26:1-3 (NASB)

1 Now there was a famine in the land, besides the previous famine that had occurred in the days of Abraham. So Isaac went to Gerar, to Abimelech king of the Philistines.

2 And the Lord appeared to him and said, “Do not go down to Egypt; stay in the land of which I shall tell you.

3 Live for a time in this land and I will be with you and bless you, for to you and to your descendants I will give all these lands, and I will establish the oath which I swore to your father Abraham.

Genesis 26:12-14 (NASB)

12 Now Isaac sowed in that land and reaped in the same year a hundred times as much. And the Lord blessed him,

13 and the man became rich, and continued to grow richer until he became very wealthy;

14 for he had possessions of flocks and herds, and a great household, so that the Philistines envied him.

The challenge with the will of God is that it often requires us to go against what we see. Often, like Paul we can see. However, we see through a blurry glass. We seldom see the big picture. We can only see what's around us. God sees our end from the beginning. **GOD NEVER REQUIRES US TO COME UP WITH INCREASE OR MAKE THINGS HAPPEN. 4. Unlimited increase is dependent upon trusting God's _____

2 Corinthians 9:6-11 (NASB)

6 Now I say this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the one who sows generously will also reap generously.

7 Each one must do just as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

8 And God is able to make all grace overflow to you, so that, always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

9 as it is written: “He scattered abroad, he gave to the poor, His righteousness endures forever.”

10 Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness;

11 you will be enriched in everything for all liberality, which through us is producing thanksgiving to God.

Something we've been given can create anything we've been promised. Heaven only responds when we move in faith. **FAITH IS THE ONLY CURRENCY GOD WILL ACCEPT.** Proof of faith in God is our willingness to take some of what God has given us and put it in circulation. Currency is something that can be exchanged for something else. **WHEN WE RELEASE WHAT WE HAVE, GOD IS AUTHORIZED TO RELEASE WHAT HE HAS.**
